How To Use This Prayer Diary

The Priority Of Prayer

Why Pray?

Prayer is central to our church's life as well as our own walk with God. As God's beloved children, we have the privilege of speaking to Him in prayer, presenting our requests and thanksgivings at His throne of grace. We hope this prayer diary will help you do that.

How to use this prayer diary?

This prayer diary is designed to do three things:

- 1) To help you pray regularly.** Praying every day requires discipline but following a daily prayer diary can help.
- 2) To help you pray for a variety of topics.** It will inform you about areas of our church's life and the needs of our mission partners.
- 3) To help you pray biblically.** Often, the prayer points either reference a Bible verse which you can look up or Bible truths to pray about. These will teach what God wants us to pray for regarding different topics.

M O N D A Y	1. Elders (Denesh, Chris & Stuart) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Thank God for the work they do in preaching & teaching and for God's help in enabling them to understand his word. - Pray that they wouldn't neglect prayer but that they'd rely on God daily (Ps 127:1).
	2. Our church family <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Thank God for how regathering on Sundays has been a huge boon relationally. - Pray that we will continue to be outward-looking - both in evangelism and discipleship.
