JESUS IS BETTER #2 (HEBREWS 1:5-2:4)

- Pray for wisdom as the church staff plans for 2023 and appoints more lay leaders.

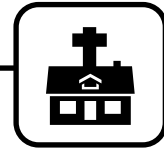
