Introduction

1. The Old Covenant sacrifices will never make us perfect (1-4)

2. Christ's sacrifice is decisively better:

a. His once-for-all sacrifice deals with sin completely (9:23-28)

b. His obedience completely fulfils God's will completely (5-10)

c. His sacrifice is a completed work (11-14)

3. The single sacrifice which “perfected” us in our relationship with God (14-18)

1. How might we be tempted to still bring “offerings” for sins? How has this passage clarified for you effects of the once-for-all sacrifice of Jesus?
2. How does knowing you are perfect/complete already help you in your struggle with sin and your relationship with God? How has Jesus sacrifice give you confidence to approach God?

- Pray for churches to see the centrality of the Word in training, evangelism & church building.

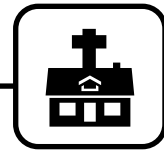
